Jim Scarpelli presented the Garmin pilot app, and Dan DeMott presented the Foreflight app on an iPad, using a Sentry GPS/ADS-B receiver.

The two apps both have many useful features, with differing formats.

For example, in addition to navigation, weather briefings, and weight and balance, some also offer a simple artificial horizon with obstacle and terrain alerts.
