Steve Hatfield and I were the only ones who flew to Liberal on 19 November to visit the fabulous Mid-America Air Museum.

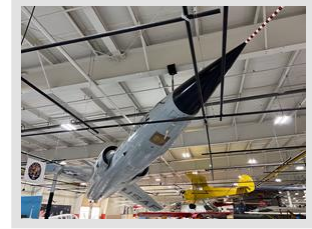
A former Beech Aircraft Company factory, this is the birthplace of the Skipper I used to get my license.
