Lead a Fly-Out, Are you Crazy!

Several members have asked me about leading fly-out and expressed their fear of volunteering. This is why I decided

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to put a few concerns to rest as well as list a few things I do that

make planning, leading, and attending the fly-outs more pleasurable than they already are!

First and foremost, you NEVER have to do this alone! When you choose to be a part of leading a fly-out, you can choose an already determined location or choose one you would like to show the group.

Second, you can not only lead, but ask to have help from another member that has already planned one and "co-lead" until you are comfortable leading on your own. Other members are ALWAYS ready and willing to help with advice, ideas, even planning and calling if information. (This allows you to get to know another member even better!)

We will never leave you to "wander all by yourself"! Ideas that have worked for me:

I try to plan a location (if I am choosing it) that can be flown to in 1 - 2 hours in a Cessna 172.

I look for local restaurants that would have a selection of food our group can choose from and pricing is average.

Once those two are done, then it is just a call to the FBO and ask if they have curtesy cars, uber and/or Taxi Service.

Then "Google is your friend", I see if I can download a menu from the restaurant and a pricing of the venue we are going to visit (If one).
